Award Criteria

Bronze Star- The Bronze Award is presented to (2) Junior 4-H members each year to honor their outstanding achievements in 4-H. The award winners will be selected based on their 4-H record book, interview, and application. A 4-H member may win this award only once. The award winners will receive a belt buckle and monetary prize.

Criteria for Selection:

- a) *The 4-H member must be considered a Junior 4-H member (3rd-5th grade) as of August 31, 2023 and have completed at least one year in 4-H including the current year.*
- b) *Compete a 4-H Record Book for current 4-H year*
- c) *Participated in 2 or more 4-H projects*

Silver Star- The Silver Star Award is presented to (2) Intermediate 4-H members each year to honor their outstanding achievements in 4-H. The award winners will be selected based on their 4-H record book, interview, and application. A 4-H member may win this award only once. The award winners will receive a belt buckle and monetary prize.

Criteria for Selection:

- a) *The 4-H member must be considered a Intermediate 4-H member (6th-8th grade) as of August 31, 2022 and have completed at least two years in 4-H including the current year.*
- b) *Compete a 4-H Record Book for current 4-H year*
- c) *Participated in 2 or more 4-H projects*

Gold Star- The Gold Star Award is the highest achievement award given by the Texas 4-H Youth Development Program. The Gold Star award can only be awarded once in a members 4-H career. The award winners will be selected based on their 4-H record book, interview, and application. The award winners will receive a belt buckle, a certificate, a pin, and a monetary prize.

Criteria for Selection:

- a) *The 4-H member must be considered a Senior 4-H member (9th-12th grade) as of August 31, 2023 and have completed at least three years in 4-H including the current year.*
- b) *Compete a 4-H Record Book for current 4-H year*
- c) *Actively participated in 3 or more projects and three activities*

Danforth – “I Dare You” Award – This award will be given to (2) Senior 4-H members. The award winners will be selected based on their 4-H record book, interview, and application. The award winners will receive a belt buckle and monetary prize.

Criteria for Selection:

- a) *The 4-H member must be considered a Senior 4-H member (9th-12th grade) as of August 31, 2023 and have completed at least three years in 4-H including the current year.*
- b) *Compete a 4-H Record Book for current 4-H year*
- c) *Actively participated in 3 or more projects and three activities*
