- PRIOR SERVICE IN A COUNTY COUNCIL OFFICER POSITION IS REQUIRED FOR THE CHAIRPERSON AND IST VICE-CHAIRPERSON.
- THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT AND IST VICE- PRESIDENT SHALL NOT BE FROM THE SAME PRIMARY CLUB.

OFFICER ELECTION PROCEDURE:

- EACH CLUB GETS 3 VOTES (I FOR PRESIDENT & 2 FOR EACH DELEGATE). IF A VOTING MEMBER IS NOT


