

**QUALITY COUNTS**- Major Show Livestock Exhibitors MUST have a Quality Counts Number. Quality Counts is an online educational experience focused on quality assurance and character education. Quality Counts is designed to teach young people the importance of displaying good character in carrying out livestock projects, and in every aspect of their lives. Quality Counts helps youth exhibitors learn the importance of using proper livestock management practices so that food quality and safety are preserved. Youth just beginning their show career, or moving to a new age level will have to take/retake this course. Exhibitors are verified at the start of each grade category:

Juniors (grades 3-5) Intermediate (grades 6-8) Senior (grades 9-12)
